My father, Wilburn Glenwood Vincent (1919-1993) did the research on this page and the other pages contained herein. He drew up some of the pedigrees and info himself while some other was either drawn up or provided by Maud McLure Kelly (1887-1973), his parents' cousin (she was kin to both).

The dilapidated condition is a result partly due from using paper that wasn't acid free and partly because it was chewed by rats while in storage. The information contained herein, however, has not been lost. Instead, it has been passed down from generation to generation.

In an email 11/7/2014 Cousin Caroline told me, "Much of Maud's information is based on [her sister] Marion's research and interviews of older relatives." Caroline descends from Maud and Marion Kelly's brother, Richard. Marion Kelly's research first started it all at least by 1905 according to the date on a letter from her cousin, Ida Vincent.

If compared with research done by later generations (Sarah Bullock, W.G. Vincent, Glynn Vincent, Caroline Feist, Ron Vincent), it means someone in our family has been doing family research for well over 100 years. Below are thumbnails of W.G. Vincent's research notes.
