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The Deed Books of Johnston County beginning in the year 1746 (year of formation) to 1759 were destroyed in a fire. There is a compiled index of the burned books which lists grantor, grantee, date of deed, book and page number (MF.95). Also pages 1 thru 187 of Deed Book B-1 are missing (see: Abstracts, Vol. I). As several of these 'burned' and 'missing' deeds appear to be mentioned in the following abstracts, a separate listing of referrals to deeds dated prior to 1763 is included on pages iv-viii. Perhaps some of these lost deeds can be reconstructed.

Deed Book E-1 is apparently a transcript and the Clerk abbreviated almost all of the Granville Grants. In later years the North Carolina State Grants were treated in the same manner. Following this method, one complete Granville Grant and one complete North Carolina State Grant may be found on pages i-iii.

Why are these abstracts NOT in chronological order? Very simple! In the early years paper was a costly item. As the original deed books became worn, the court would order the clerk or register to purchase a new blank book in which to recopy the deeds from the worn books. Unfortunately the original books did not become worn in the same order in which they were compiled...but EVERY page of a new blank book had to be utilized. As in this Vol. a new blank book became Transcript 2 which contains deeds from original Deed Books F-1, N-1, P-1, & R-1. Transcript 3 contains original Deed Book Q-1 & at least one (or more?) unidentified original book. Thus the deeds are no longer in chronological order by deed book designation.

The original indices of the above deed books have been included in this vol. (see Contents page) but the names have NOT been duplicated in the compiled index.
